Annals of West University of Timisoara, Series of Chemistry is an open access journal (<http://www.elearning-chemistry.ro/awut/>) that publishes research (primary) papers on all aspects of the theory and application of chemistry. The journal appears with 1 volume per year, with 2 regular issues (numbers) and with (2) special issues. Special issues are designated for publishing the Proceedings of National and/or International Scientific Meetings (held in Timișoara) of which Faculty of Chemistry-Biology-Geography is (co-) organizer.

Articles published in the journal comprise only original articles (in the form of preliminary research, short communication and full papers). In addition to research papers, the journal offers review articles (commissioned by the Editors) that can be published in booklet form in some extensions of journal named: “**Seria Monografii de Chimie**” or “**Seria Monografii de Biochimie Cuantică și Interacții Specifice**” (usually in Romanian language, but English is welcomed). For a full and complete guide for authors, please refer to the most up-to-date version of Instruction for Authors. It is recommended that the journal name is put in the subject field of the message’s “envelope” information.

All manuscripts submitted to *Annals of West University of Timisoara, Series of Chemistry* must be submitted solely to this journal, may not have been published in any part or form in another publication of any type, professional or lay, and become the property of Editors. Papers for consideration should be submitted in duplicate (hardcopies) to Editors of *Annals of West University of Timisoara, Series of Chemistry*, Str. Pestalozzi 16, 300115, Timisoara, Romania. The author(s) should submit with the revised manuscript an electronic copy identical to the hard copy. The electronic version should be provided on a high-density diskette (or CD ROM), with all files saved in a Windows™ compatible format. The journal will not be responsible for the loss of manuscripts at any time. All statements in, or omissions from, published manuscripts are the responsibility of the authors, who will assist the editors by reviewing proofs before publication. Reprint order forms will be sent with the proofs.

Subscription prices are available upon request from the Publisher or Editors. Subscriptions are accepted on a prepaid basis only and are entered on a calendar year basis. Issues are sent by standard mail (surface within Europe, air delivery outside Europe). Priority rates are available upon request. All articles accepted for publication in Annals of West University of Timisoara – Series of Chemistry are processed using electronic production methods. Authors should therefore ensure that their artwork conforms to the following guidelines:

Authors are asked to conform exactly to the requirement of journal style. Write your article only using the most up-to-date version of template Annals ChemWUT.doc file.

The title page should contain the complete title of the manuscript, names and affiliations of all authors, institution at which the work was performed, name and address for correspondence, and a running head of not more than 45 characters.

Abstract should be a factual condensation of the entire work and include statements of the problems, methods of study, results and conclusions. The abstract may not exceed 250 words.

Key word – submit five to ten key words that will adequately index the subject matter of the article

The text should (and please conform strictly to this requirement) follow the format: Introduction, Materials and Methods, Results, Discussion and Conclusions. Place acknowledgements as the last element of the text, before references. Subheadings and paragraph titles are accepted, but use them as rare as possible.

References - In the text, references should be cited consecutively as numerals in brackets. In the final list, they should be in numerical order, include the names of all authors and the complete title of the article cited. Journal names should be abbreviated according to the international rules. Do not use all capitals, do not underline.

Tables must be numbered in order of appearance with Roman numerals. Each must have a title and be keyed into the text.

Illustrations – All illustrations must be numbered in order of appearance with Arabic numerals. Insert your illustration directly in the text (preferably in a text box). A legend must accompany each illustration and must define all abbreviations used therein. For Print Edition (ISSN 1224-9513) all images and artwork has to be sent in grayscale images with a minimum of 300 dpi resolution. Lines should have a minimum width of 0.5 pt. An image which looks acceptable on a computer may not reproduce well, so it is important to ensure that these guidelines are followed.

For CD-Edition (ISSN 1584-1286) and On-Line Edition (ISSN 1584-1294) the images can be sent as color images with 300 dpi resolution (although grayscale images are accepted equally). Line should be a minimum with of 0.5 pt. Only standard colors should be used.

The Editors tank to all the authors for their cooperation in this matter, and through its application look forward to better serving the Journal and its readers by providing the most efficient and timely review and production process available.
